## Gender Identity

#### New students

### BOOK FEES:

\$100.00 for K-2/K-3/K-4

\$135.00 for K-5

\$250.00 for 1st - 5th Grade

\$260.00 for 6th Grade

\$280.00 for 7th/8th/9th Grade

\*If you are enrolling 3 children, their book fees are discounted by 50% on the youngest child. If you are enrolling a 4th child, the book fee is waived for the 4th child.

WITHDRAWAL FEE: **Non-Refundable \$150.00** per student

**BEFORE CARE:** (6:30a-7:45a) - \$130.00 per student per month (Includes a nutritious breakfast) or \$20.00 per day

**AFTER CARE:** (3:30p-6:00p) - \$150.00 per student per month (Includes a nutritious snack) or \$25.00 per day \***Please Note:** \$5 per minute late fees apply if students are picked up **after** 6:00 p.m.

**TUITION: Yearly or Monthly (10 months) Full Days**

### TUITION PRICES:

K2/K3: \$3,900/year or \$390/month for 10 months

K4/K5: \$4,000/year or \$400/month for 10 months

1st - 2nd Grade: \$4,100/year or \$410/month for 10 months

3rd - 4th Grade: \$4,200/year or \$420/month for 10 months

5th - 6th Grade: \$4300/year or \$430/month for 10 months

7th - 8th Grade: \$4400/year or \$440/month for 10 months

9th Grade: \$4500/year or \$450/month for 10 months

\*If you have 2 or more children enrolled at TWA, the 1st two children pay full price for tuition and the 3rd (youngest) child receives a 50% discount on tuition.

**LUNCH: \$63** (per month) or **\$3.50** (per day)

\*All fees must be paid at the time your child is enrolled. The parent or guardian must pay on or before the 5<sup>th</sup> of every month. After the 5<sup>th</sup>, if payment has not been received, a **\$20.00 per day** late fee will be added to your tuition, **including weekends**. If payment has not been made by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, the child will **NOT** be permitted to attend school until **ALL** payments have been made. **All payments must be paid on time. Delinquent accounts must be settled within 30 days; otherwise student accounts will be turned over to The Financial Law Firm and/or The Advance Bureau of Collections.**

## Student Requirements & Information

Students may be admitted to TWA only after meeting the following requirements:

### **Requirements:**

- a) Copy of student's birth certificate
- b) Certificate of immunization  
(Georgia Form 3231)
- c) Certificate of Eye, Ear & Dental Exam  
(Georgia Form 3300)

### **New vaccination requirements:**

- (1) **Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine**
  - (2) **Hepatitis A Vaccine**
- Additional doses to existing vaccine requirements for children entering Kindergarten, 9th grade or new entrant in any grade (Kindergarten - 9th Grade)
    - (1) **Mumps 2nd dose**
    - (2) **Varicella 2nd dose**
  - Four-year-old children, born on or before December 1st and were issued a Georgia Form 3231, must have their immunization status evaluated for entry into Kindergarten.
  - Grade level testing may be required by the Administrator.

## Student Requirements & Information Cont'd



**Uniforms** are required for all students who attend TWA. The uniform consists of **navy** pants or shorts for boys and navy dresses, skirts, shorts or slacks for girls; **White, Lt. Blue, Navy Blue, or Red** polo style shirts, button down shirts, or blouses only. Shoes must be **Navy Blue, Black, Dark Brown or White**; Belts - **Black, Dark Brown, or Navy Blue**, must be worn if pants have belt loops. **\*Please Note: Red Polo** shirts can be worn **daily** and will also be worn on Field Trips. Additional clothing styles are provided during enrollment.

### **School Hours (Full Day)**

Starts - 8:00 a.m. Ends - 3:00 p.m.

**First day of school:** Wednesday, August 1, 2018
